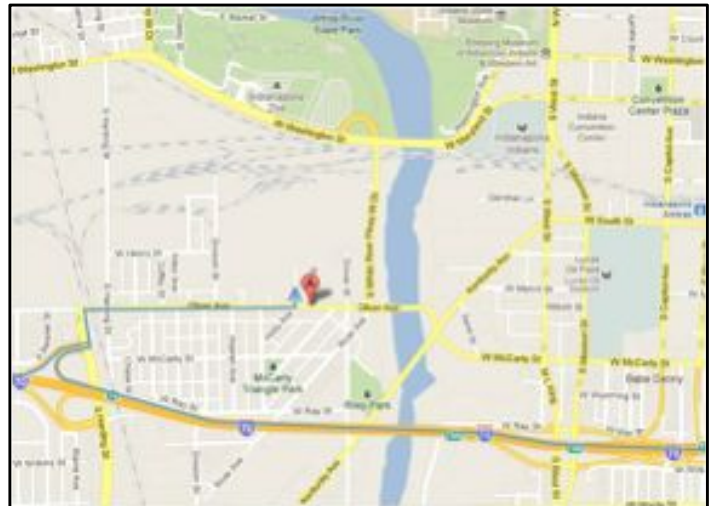
(Shuttle Provided to Indiana Convention Center and Lucas Oil Stadium)

From I-65, North or South, I-65 to I-70 west to Exit 78 to Harding St. Turn left on Harding St. to Oliver Ave. Turn right on Oliver Ave to GM Stamping Plant Parking Area. Follow signs and staff.

From I-70, West and Airport, I-70 east to Exit 78 to Harding St. Turn left on Harding St. to Oliver Ave. Turn right on Oliver Ave to GM Stamping Plant Parking Area. Follow signs and staff.

From I-70, East, I-70 West to Exit 78 to Harding St. Turn left on Harding St. to Oliver Ave. Turn right on Oliver Ave to GM Stamping Plant Parking Area. Follow signs and staff.

From I-74, West, I-74 west to I-465. Keep Left at the fork and follow signs for I-465 S / I74 W and merge onto I-465 S / I-74 W. Exit onto I-65 N. Exit onto I-70 west. Take Exit 78 to Harding St. Turn left on Harding St. to Oliver Ave. Turn right on Oliver Ave to GM Stamping Plant Parking Area. Follow signs and staff.





DIRECTIONS FROM GM STAMPING LOT SHUTTLE DROP TO VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN AREA

(for all Lucas Oil Stadium rehearsals, NOT including Game Day)

1. Shuttle busses will run continuously from the GM Stamping lot to the “Red Lot A” drop off/load location (S. West St. at W. McCarty St.)
2. Once off the shuttle, follow the pedestrian path below:
 - South on S. West St. to W. McCarty St.
 - East on W. McCarty St. to S. Missouri St.
 - North on S. Missouri St. to GATE 3 (look for blue “Gate 3” sign)
 - Go up the stairs at Gate 3, and follow the signs to “Volunteer Check-In”
3. You will use the same (reverse) route at the conclusion of rehearsals to get back to the shuttle bus loading area, and back to the GM Stamping Lot

DO NOT J-WALK!

PLEASE USE CROSSWALKS AT S. WEST ST. AND S. MISSOURI ST.

They are both multi-lane one-way streets, with a great deal of vehicle traffic.
